- Current Chipman enrollment is 539 students.
- AAMS enrollment is up to 491 as of March 18th.
- Wood Middle School can accept up to 180 more students without additional structural changes.
- Change current Chipman attendance boundaries to become part of Wood attendance zone (attendance area west of Park Street)



Outreach to Undecided Families—down to approximately 40 students
