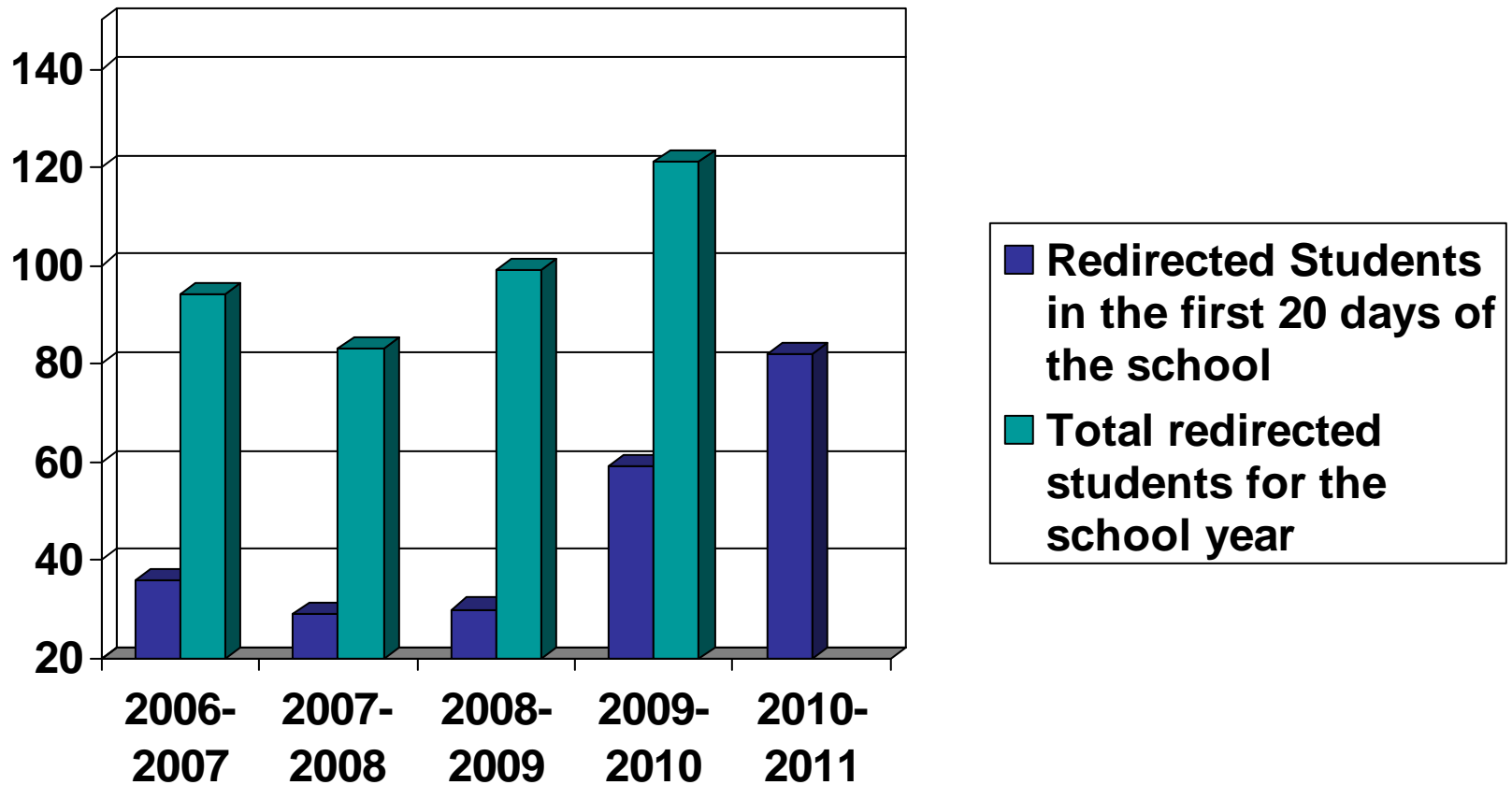

# **Day 20 Enrollment 10-11**

## ***Enrollment Policy – Transfers due to over enrollment***

- Parents Notified in writing at registration
  
- Ask for voluntary transfers
  
- Involuntary transfers redirected to other schools, based on enrollment date
  - Students on interdistrict and Allen Bill permits first
  - Redirected students (intra districts) if all the following conditions are met:
    - There is a demand on their space at the current school by a resident living within the school boundaries, and
    - There is space at the redirected students home school, and
    - Within the first two year of being redirected. After two years redirected students may remain at the school of attendance through the 5<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
  
  - Students residing in attendance area last

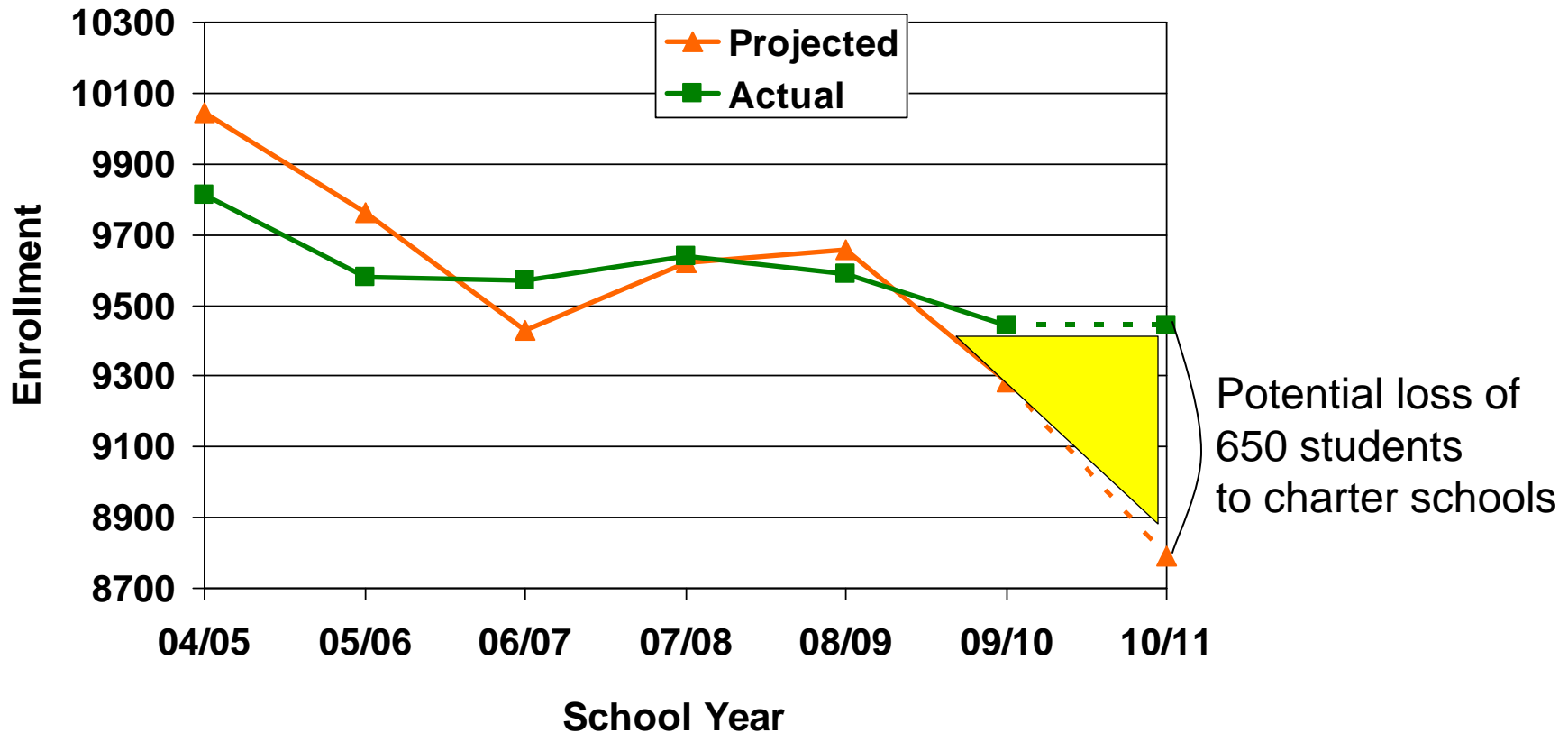
