Master Plan Strategies Update: Magnet Survey Results

Board Meeting 10/13/09

Highlights

- 78% of survey respondents were very interested or interested in magnets (53% were very interested)
- Dual language immersion, science and technology, and school of the arts themes were the most popular
- A dual language immersion theme was the most popular for elementary school
- A science and technology theme was the most popular theme for middle and high school
- An International Baccalaureate theme was by far the most popular suggestion for those suggesting "other types"

Highlights

- As of October 8, there were 249 respondents to the on-line survey
- Respondents were from all across Alameda, with some variation between school zones.
- Nearly half (48%) of respondents were elementary parents
- 28% of respondents were preschool parents

Overall Take-Aways - Summary of Specific Points of Concern

- Program may cost too much (5)
- Restrict students to a specialized theme too early in their education (4)
- Students are not exposed to a diversity of topics/themes (5)
- May be great, but AUSD needs more than a magnet program to reform (3)
- May not provide a quality education for all students (10)
- Themes should be spread across all schools (6)
- May weaken existing schools by taking resources (6)
- May be overwhelming to students (3)
- AUSD doesn't need specialized education teach the basics (3)
- Students/Families may lose current, valuable community (6)
- Hasn't been implemented yet; it depends on details (9)
- Sustainability (2)
- AUSD schools are already great (2)
- Transportation (5)
